The Construction Products Association represents and champions manufacturers and suppliers of construction products and materials.

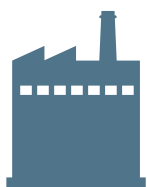

Our sector accounts for 13% of total UK manufacturing and a third of all UK construction turnover – a £62 billion industry of 24,000 companies employing 383,000 people, mainly across the Midlands and North.
