Approximately 75% of all construction products and materials used in the UK are manufactured here, reflecting an industry that underpins nearly every construction project in the country, large and small. Our sector accounts for 13% of total UK manufacturing and a third of all UK construction turnover – a £62 billion industry of 24,000 companies employing 383,000 people, mainly across the Midlands and North.
